

- Basically FCFS, but priority for D-J-F collaborations
- Prerequesite: no other funding support available
- Prerequesite: real research stay (> 1 month)
- Informal request via mail to Benjamin Uekermann
- Goals:
 - Foster international collaboration, in particular with F/J
 - Provide support for young researchers to go abroad
 - Invitation of young researchers from international partner institutions to doctoral retreat
